Reference Rule No. 205 of IRCA Coaching Tariff No.26, Part 1 (VOI.I) regarding Circular Journey Tickets (CJTs) & Board's Commercial Circular No.50 of 2008 dated 22.07.2008.

- 2. It is clarified that repetition of stations on circular journey tickets is not prohibited. However, the total number of stations, which the passenger is required to advise for break journey, shall not exceed the maximum number of stations mentioned in this rule.
