1.0 North Chennai Parliament Constituency - R.K. Nagar Assembly Constituency - Ennore High Road and Manali Saliai Junction - `T' Shape Over Bridge Construction work - Work to be stared - Regarding. It's submitted that work for construction of ROBs on two level crossing (LC No.2A and LC No.2B), about 750m apart, in Chennai was sanctioned in 2016. Railways in Railway portion and state Government in approaches, had fixed agencies for construction works in 2016 itself.

As ROBs are to be constructed on same alignment, the road traffic though the above level crossings was to be diverted by the Greater Chennai Corporation and Chennai City Police. Since these authorities have failed to take necessary action to divert the road traffic as requested by the Railways, the contracts have been closed in 2020 by the Railways.

Request - Railways is requested to call for fresh tenders for this projects and it may be assured that our Government under the Stewardship of Hon'ble Chief Minister Thiru. M.K. Stalin will take all necessary steps including diversion of Traffic to complete project.

Response:

Hon'ble MP, North Chennai has inspected site & conducted meetings on 08.07.2021 & 31.07.2021 with officials of Railways, Police (Traffic) and Greater Chennai Corporation. During the meeting held on 31.07.2021 it has been decided as following:

- i) Instead of single 'T' shaped bridge, GCC has proposed to construct two independent bridges for the benefit of the local public residing in that area to easily access the Bus stops.
- ii) Bridge work at level crossing 2-B will be taken up firstly, since the proposal does not require Land Acquisition.
- iii) GCC requested the Railways to adopt Bow Sting type single span bridge at both Level crossings, so that the ramps can be accommodated well within the road junction.
- iv)GCC informed that revised administrative sanction has to be obtained from Government, since the proposal has been modified as against the earlier administrative sanction accorded by the Government.
- v) GCC informed that design & drawings and estimate for the revised proposal have to be prepared and revised Administrative Sanction will be obtained within 3 months.

Alignment details are awaited from GCC for GAD preparation. (HQ advised vide W.352/M/213/214/CN dt 6.8.2021 and W.352/GN/GL/REP dt 29.7.2021)

2.0 Outgoing trains from chennai and incoming trains from Delhi, Kolkata to stop at Tiruvottiyur Railway Station. All inbound and outbound trains should stop at Tiruvottiyur railway station and trains passing through Vijayawada and 4 trains to Hyderabad, all these trains can stop at Tiruvottiyur Railway station. All inbound and outbound Trains should stop at Tiruvottiyur Station.

Response of Railway authorities: As Tiruvottiyur Railway Station platform is not of adequate length, train having large number of coaches could not be accommodated.

Request:- Tiruvottiyur Railway Station is currently having 12 coaches platform it should be extended to 24 coaches stop platform, so as to stop all express trains in this station. FOB (Foot Over Bridge) to be available at both ends of platform. Ticket counter (at least automated) to be made available on the side where no counter is available.

Response:

The extant policy of Railway Board does not permit provision of stoppage of additional Express trains at stations served by suburban trains.

ATVM has been indented and feasibility of providing on the other side will be explored.

3.0 Intake of ACT Apprenticeship training candidates from Tamil Nadu is very poor. 100% intake of ACT apprenticeship training only from Tamil Nadu State candidates will help greater employment opportunity for more number of poor candidates of Tamil Nadu.

Response:

- 1) The eligibility to Act Apprentices intake at present is already restricted to the applicants over the Jurisdiction of Southern Railway. i.e. The residents of whole Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Kerala and only the particular districts of Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka where the Railway stations available/situated within the Geographical Jurisdiction of Southern Railway. Similarly, the residents of Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep Islands are also eligible to apply.
- 2) However, it is seen that there are not enough takers for these vacancies notified. Thus for the 2021-22 recruitment, against 3378 slots, only 2092 candidates have been empanelled of which so far 930 have joined. The remaining candidates are yet to report.
- 3) Thus all efforts are made to get applicants only from the Southern Region. Recently a special drive was conducted against which 88 only have been enrolled.

4.0 Extension of Chennai bound trains upto Southern districts Kanyakumari, Rameswaram, Madurai, Trichi, Tirinelveli, Tuticorin, Nagercoil, Karaikal, Villupuram for the benefit of Southern Districts people and allot more reservation quota to Chennai based passengers.

Response:

Powers of extension of trains are vested with Railway Board.

Reservation quota is fixed based on the reserved passenger traffic and same is being reviewed periodically.

5.0 New Express train between Chennai and Thoothukudi.

Response:

Due to terminal constraints at Chennai Egmore, at present it is not feasible to introduce new trains between Chennai Egmore and Tuticorin.

6.0 The following railway level crossing locations are required with replacement of Road over/ under bridges, as they pass through heavy road traffic.

The location specified in your letter does not have railway station reference and hence unable to confirm the location which is sought for Kendriya Vidyalaya School. However, if such request is initiated form Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, the same will be considered as per extant rules with the approval of Railway Board provided the land requested is not required for Railway's future development works.

This apart, 40 CCTV cameras were installed at MTMY Railway station to prevent the passenger crimes.
