Suftable changes in schedule and stoppages of above trains may be undertaken to decrease the running time which will improve the occupancy of this train. This will also reduce congestion at DEE, rake reversal and crossing at DBSI Station during grouping time in the morning and will thus help in improving punctuality of trains coming from and going to Rewari as well as SSB.

Example- 22941/22942 INDB-JAT & 22705/22706 TPTY-JAT too are running via DSJ with no watering over DLI division. Schedule of 6 pairs of M/Express trains coming from. Konkan Railway is revised from 1st June to 31st Oct. every year. Schedule of all these trains should not be changed during Monsoon. Otherwise the Monsoon schedule should be regularized on permanent basis and printed in regular Time Table. Any midterm change in schedule affects schedule of other regular timetabled trains.
