

Zonal Railways In Madhya Pradesh

West Central Railway



West Central Railway (WCR) Zone with its headquarter at Jabalpur consists of Jabalpur and Bhopal and Kota divisions. The gazette notification announcing the formation of this new zonal railway was issued on 4th July 2002. It has a total route kilometers of 2911 kms

Some sections of WCR falling in M.P. State are the parts of important routes of Indian Railways such as Howrah-Mumbai route via Satna-Jabalpur-Itarsi in the east west direction, Delhi-Chennai route via Bina-Bhopal-Itarsi, Delhi-Mumbai route via Bina-Bhopal-Khandwa in the north-south direction. The sections of

Katni-Singrauli, Satna-Rewa, Jukehi-Kymore, Katni-Bina-Guna-Kota and Maksi (excluding)-Guna-Gwalior (excluding) are within the jurisdiction of West Central Railway and cater to 24 districts of M.P.

South Eastern Central Railway

South East Central Railway (SECR) zone with its headquarter at Bilaspur consists of the Bilaspur and Nagpur divisions of former the South Eastern Railway and the new Raipur division. It has a total route kilometers of 2489 kms.

New Katni Junction (excluding)-Shahdol-Anuppur section of Bilaspur Division and Chhindwara-Nagpur section, Jabalpur-Gondia section, Nainpur-Chhindwara-Nagpur section, Nainpur-Mandla section of Nagpur Division are within the jurisdiction of South Eastern Central Railway and cater to 9 districts of M.P.



Western Railway



Western Railway zone with its headquarter at Mumbai consists of Mumbai, Ahemdabad, Vadodara, Rajkot, Ratlam and Bhavnagar divisions. The major railway routes of Indian Railways which come under Western Railways are Ratlam-Mumbai Central, Ahmedabad - Mumbai and Palanpur - Ahmedabad. It has a total route kilometers of 6181 kms.

Its Nagda-Ratlam-Dahod section of Delhi-Mumbai Rajdhani route falls in the state of M.P. Bhopal-Ujjain-Nagda section, Khandwa-Indore-Ratlam section, Indore-Dhar-Chhota Udepur section and Ratlam-Neemach section of Ratlam division caller to 11 districts of M.P.

Zonal Railways In Madhya Pradesh



Central Railway

Central Railway zone with its headquarter in Mumbai at Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus consists of Mumbai, Bhusawal, Pune, Nagpur and Sholapur divisions. It includes the first passenger railway line in India, which opened from Mumbai to Thane on 16 April 1853. It has a total route Kms of 3743 Kms.

Mumbai-Howrah route via Khandwa-Burhanpur section in Bhusawal division and Jujharpur-Amla section on Delhi-Chennai route, Chhindwara-Amla section in Nagpur division are within the jurisdiction of Central Railway and cater to 5 districts of M.P.

North Central Railway

North Central Railway zone with its headquarter at Allahabad came to be recognized as a separate entity from 1st April 2003. This was done to meet the growing demand for transportation facilities for this zone. The North Central Railway serves a large area of North India with its divisions at Allahabad, Jhansi and Agra. The trains plying at North Central Railway connect Madhya Pradesh, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan states. It has a total route Kms of 3216 Kms.



Delhi-Chennai route via Morena-Gwalior-Datia section, and Lalitpur-Chhatarpur-Khajuraho section, Gwalior-Sheopur section, Gwalior-Bhind-Etawah section are within the jurisdiction of North Central Railway and cater to 8 districts of M.P.




