Note:

1. The impact on freight trains at MDJN point to be reduced by running of more no of long hauls.

2. Before work starts of BPNI, detailed TWO must be issued to all concerned and copy to HO.

3. All SRs of 20 kmph will be relaxed to 30 kmph on  $2^{nd}$  day and 45 kmph on  $3^{rd}$  day and 75 kmph on  $5^{th}$  day.

4. PQRS, LHS/RUB & other engineering blocks (except emergency) will not be given.

5. FTR and other special trains will be regulated accordingly.

 During Pre & post NI Senior Scale officers and during NI, JA Grade officer of CNST, S&T and Engineering of open line will remain at site.

- 7. After NI traffic staff and S&T staff will remain for 3 days more at station to avoid detention of trains in case of failure.
- 8. During NI operating officers and CSTE/C will remain at site.
- 9. To keep EA consumption with in limit, all other TSRs imposed on FL-MDJN-AII, AII-MJ and MJ-JU will be removed before starting the work of Pre NI.
- 10. All division will ensure all safety precaution for safe running of trains during the work.
- 11. DRM/AII, PCSTE & PCE will assess preparedness and adequate resources in terms of materials & manpower before starting pre NI and NI work to avoid any chance of failure, including block bursting.
- 12. Multiple block without regulating coaching train will be provided during post NI for welding work, tamping.
- 13. No Caution Order will be allowed other than mentioned in given NI planning during pre NI, NI and Post NI.
- 14. The work will be executed as per planning submitted by the division.
- 15. Freight traffic on the section shall be planned in such a manner so that detention is minimized.
- 16. Interchange of freight trains at PNU and CNA point shall be maintained as committed.

It should be ensured that trains regulated during block period are made up so that there link trains originate right time.

All efforts should be made to ensure completion of work within allowed duration with minimum detention to trains in the affected section with adequate supervision at an appropriate level. The division should ensure that adjacent divisions are informed well in advance to ensure the effective utilization of shadow block for maintenance works. **All concerned to please note and take necessary action accordingly.**
