Sub: Upgradation of trains - Project Utkrisht (उत्कृष्ट).

In order to improve the condition of coaches running in Mail / Express trains, it has been decided to upgrade 66 pairs of trains comprising of 140 rakes. Fot this purpose, an RSP for upgradation of 66 pairs of trains (140 rakes) has been included in the Pink Book 2018-19 @ Rs.60 lakhs per rake (RSP P. B. Item No.1206/18-19 under Head of Allocation 'CAP'). It has also been decided to name this endeavour as Project Utkrisht (3cq.). The list of rakes/trains for Project Utkrisht are enclosed at Annexure 'A'. In case, any change is desired in the allotted trains / rakes, same may be communicated to Railway Board with the approval of concerned PCME. The target date for completion of the work rake-wise should be advised to Board latest by 30.04.18.

It is expected that Zonal Railways will work towards achieving sustainable improvement in the condition of coaches while executing this work. The scope of work listed as **Annexure 'B'** is indicative in nature and divisions may cover additional items as per requirement.

Further, some of the items listed in the scope of work of upgradation are already covered under revenue or other RSP sanctions. It shall be ensured that during execution, such items are not booked against this RSP for upgradation of trains.

Regular monitoring of Project Utkrisht shall be ensured at Zonal Head Quarter level also. The updated progress of the project shall be communicated to Railway Board on monthly basis. A Google Sheet to monitor the progress will be uploaded after 2 months (i.e. June, 2018). Zonal Railways are requested to update the progress on this Google Sheet also.

Immediate action may be taken by Zonal Railways to plan the work and initiate tendering etc required for Project Utkrisht. However, no financial commitment under this RSP may be entered into till the Budget 2018-19 is passed.

## Project Utkrisht: Scope of work

The following items are to be attended for upgradation of the trains:

## I On Board Cleanliness (In case train falls under OBHS scheme)

- 1. In case train falls under OBHS scheme, OBHS should be functional and following should be ensured:
  - a. GPS tagged biometric attendance system. Train should be covered under Clean my coach/ Coach Mitra.
  - b. Cleaning of toilets to be done every 2 Hrs. and Chart should be available in toilet duly filled.
  - c. Training to Janitors should be imparted & Certificate to this effect available.
- 2. Garbage bag in dustbins in coach and toilets.
- 3. Regular collection of garbage from dustbins to be ensured.
- 4. Toilet choking to be attended on urgent basis while on run. OBHS staff to be trained for removal of choking.

### II Coach Interiors

. . .

- 1. PVC flooring to be changed if defaced/damaged.
- 2. All seats/berths with torn rexine/compressed cushioning material to be replaced. It should be ensured that only one colour of rexine is used in a coach.
- 3. Coach panels having patches/faded sheets to be replaced with new panels.
- 4. All passenger amenity item to be available as per standard list.
- 5. Good quality curtains to be provided in AC coaches as per existing instructions. Periodic cleaning of curtains should be ensured.
- 6. All broken roof panels or having patches to be replaced by NAFTC panels. Painting of roof to be done with white paint if required.
- 7. Suitable good posters to be provided to improve aesthetics inside the coaches.
- 8. Vinyl wrapping of doorway and gang way area to be carried out.
- 9. LED Lighting to be provided in the coach.
- 10. Buffing of Stainless Steel fittings to be done every month.
- 11. Toilet indication in AC coaches to be provided.
- 12. Single Information Poster & standard Braille signage to be provided
- 13. Double acting partitions door to be provided in AC coaches.
- 14. The vestibule and vestibule door to be in proper working condition.
- 15. Chequered plate in door way area to be replaced if worn out.
- 16. Dustbins to be provided in doorway area in all coaches.
- 17. Fire extinguishers to be provided in all reserved coaches.
- 18. Standard washbasin with uniform taps to be provided.
- 19. Paint touch up.

#### III Toilets

- 1. PVC flooring to be replaced with epoxy flooring with proper floor level and slope so that there is no water puddle.
- 2. All bio-toilets to be in working order, after primary. All coaches to have S-trap bio-toilets,
- 3. In case of CDTS, it should be functional.
- 4. Improved flushing valves as per RDSO directions to be provided.
- 5. SS dustbins as per RDSO drawing to be provided in all toilets.
- 6. Good quality taps and toilet fittings to be provided.
- 7. AC coaches to be provided with good quality soap dispensers.
- 8. Proper ventilation system to be provided in all coaches.
- 9. Toilet doors with proper louvers to be provided.
- 10. Buffing of Stainless Steel fittings to be done every month.
- 11. Provision of health faucets in all coaches to be ensured.
- 12. LED lights to be provided in the toilets.
- 13. Proper quality seat and seat covers to be provided in western style toilets with provision of seat cover dispensers for AC coaches.
- 14. Defective/broken/patch/faded toilet panels to be replaced or vinyl wrapping to be carried out.
- 15. Gaps in toilet door and wall to be removed in all toilets.
- 16. Auto janitor system to be installed in AC coaches to control bad odour.

### IV Exterior

Good Quality destination boards to be provided.

### V Pantry

All equipment to be in working condition, and pantry with gas based cooking system to have safety certification as per laid down norms. A certificate to this effect to be displayed in the pantry.

**NOTE**: The items listed above are indicative in nature. This list covers items under revenue and other RSP's works also. The item not covered under any other RSP shall only be executed under this RSP, sanctioned @ Rs.60 lakhs / Rake.
