**Jamnagar Railway Station** is the main railway station in the city of <u>Jamnagar</u> in <u>Gujarat</u>, <u>India</u>. It is located in the <u>Western Railways</u> zone of Rajkot Division. Jamnagar railway station is connected to various parts of India by long distance trains. <u>Hapa</u>is another railway station located on the eastern outskirts of Jamnagar.

## History

Jamnagar railway station was owned by Jamnagar & Dwarka Railway during Princely rule. The Rajkot-Jamnagar line was opened by 1897<sup>[1]</sup> and the Jamnagar-Okha section was opened in 1922 by Jamnagar & Dwarka Railway. Jamnagar & Dwarka Railway was merged into Saurashtra Railway in April 1948. Saurashtra Railway was merged into Western Railway on 5 November 1951. Gauge conversion of Viramgam-Hapa section were completed by 1980 and on the Hapa-Okha section by 1984 by Indian Railways. It has 7 daily trains and many weekly trains to various parts of India.

## **Trains**

There are total 48 trains that pass through Jamnagar railway station. 12477 JAM SVDK Express, 19018 Saurashtra Janta Express and 19060 Jamnagar Surat Intercity originate from Jamnagar railway station.

## **Facilities**

Jamnagar railway station has an <u>ATM</u> run by the State Bank of India. It has numerous stalls selling packed foods, flavoured milk, ice creams and other hot snacks. It also has a dormatory for passengers looking to stay overnight. There is an air conditioned waiting room for passengers with 3AC or higher tickets. Work for escalators will start soon
