







INCREASED CAPITAL INVESTMENTS

Average annual budget grant of Railways in Odisha increased by 439% in 2019-20 in comparison with 2009-14




Capital Expenditure increased by 403% in 2018-19 in comparison with 2013-14




New Line between Khurda Road and Nayagarh Town

Doubling has gone up from 16 Kms per year in 2004-14 to 102 Kms per year in 2014-19



Fast Track Electrification

Electrification of tracks has gone up per year from 35 Kms between 2004-14 to 211 Kms between 2014-19.



- ❖ 1054 route Kms electrified since 2014
- ❖ Electrification of another 625 route Kms sanctioned in 2018-19 at a cost of ₹554 Crore

Electrified Train Route near Cuttack Station




All Unmanned Level Crossings Eliminated

- ❖ All Unmanned Level Crossings has been eliminated by commissioning 13 Road Under Bridges (RUBs)/Sub-Ways, Diverting 07 Level Crossings to other substitute way and Manning 97 UMLCs.
- ❖ In the past five years, 525 numbers of Unmanned Level Crossings have been closed in East Coast Railway jurisdiction.
- Will avoid accidents at level crossings as well as increase sectional capacity



- ❖ Government approved 130 Kms Jeypore-Malkangiri New Line project to be completed by 2022
- At present Malkangiri has no Rail connectivity
- Completion Cost ₹ 2,676 Crore
- Will result in short lead to many other places of Odisha,
 Chhattisgarh and Andhra Pradesh





Moving Odisha's Economy: Freight



- Providing essential raw materials to Power Plants and Industries
- ❖ Backbone of operations at 3 Important Ports-Paradeep, Dhamra & Gopalpur

- ❖ 12 private sidings commissioned in the last 5 years
- Dunguripalli, Junagarh Road, Brundamal and Kakriguma 4 new stations opened for handling goods traffic



Passenger Amenities

- Adarsh Stations: 18 Stations have been upgraded as Adarsh Stations during last 5 years
- **Extension of Platforms:** Extension of Platforms and additional Platforms were provided at 62 Stations during last 5 years
- ❖ Foot Over Bridges: Foot Over Bridges at 61 Stations were provided between 2014-19. To enhance the safety of rail users, Railways have decided to provide Foot Over Bridges at all the small stations. Now, all the small stations including Passenger Halts of Odisha will get their first over bridge
- ❖ Washable Aprons: For better hygienic environment, 50 Stations have been provided with Washable Aprons between 2014-19

Passenger Amenities

- Lifts & Escalators: 11 Lifts have been provided at Bhubaneswar, Cuttack, Rourkela, Brahmapur and Sambalpur. 20 Escalators have been installed at Bhubaneswar, Rourkela, Sambalpur, Cuttack, Brahmapur, Khurda Road and Jharsuguda.
- ❖ Automatic Sanitary Pad Vending Machine: Automatic Sanitary Pad Vending Machines have been installed at Bhubaneswar, Khurda Road and Sambalpur Stations. This service has been extended in some important Express Trains also, first time in Indian Railways.
- Station Ticket Booking Sevak & Automated Ticket Vending Machine: 139 Station Ticket Booking Sevak were provided during last 5 years. 44 Automated Ticket Vending Machines also provided at important Stations
- Water Vending Machine: Water Vending Machines have been installed at about 94 locations at 21 Stations of Odisha

- ❖ Air-Conditioned Waiting Halls: All major Railway Stations of Odisha have been provided with Air-Conditioned Waiting Halls
- ❖ Battery Operated Vehicle: Battery Operated Vehicles have been provided for Senior Citizens and Divyang-Jan at Bhubaneswar, Puri, Cuttack and Titlagarh
- * Medicine Store: Facilities of Medicine Store have been provided at Bhubaneswar and Puri Stations
- Food Plaza: Food Plazas have been opened at Bhubaneswar, Puri, Cuttack, Jajpur-Keonjhar Road, Brahmapur, Rourkela, Jharsuguda and Sambalpur Railway Stations
- ❖ Foldable Portable Ramp: For convenience of Divyang Passengers, Portable Wheel Chair Ramp facilities are now available at Bhubaneswar, Sambalpur stations and being extended to other Stations

Green Initiatives

- * Bottle Recycling Machine: Bottle Recycling Machines have been installed at Bhubaneswar & Puri Railway Stations to avoid plastic garbage at the station premises and on tracks
- ❖ Bio-Toilets: Trains originating / terminating in Odisha are fitted with 6148 bio-toilets in 1689 Coaches. Khurda Road - Puri Section has been declared as Green Train Corridor. All the trains running in this section will be provided with bio-toilets
- ❖ Solar Energy: 2 x 50 KWP Solar Power Plant has been installed at Rail Sadan (ECoR HQ) roof top. Solar Water Geysers have been provided in driver/guard running rooms at Puri and Angul. 6 Solar Panels have also been installed at Baripada Station for station lighting. Total 988 KWP Solar modules provided for Solar Energy during last 5 years
- ❖ Water Treatment Plant : In order to prevent soil pollution, Effluent Water Treatment Plants are functioning at several Diesel and Electric Loco sheds. Sewerage water is disposed off through the designated pipeline with a specified method to avoid soil pollution


